## Canada Post Service Disruption

The Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW) have given notice that it intends to hold rotating strikes in certain areas of the country for 24 hour periods resulting on no mail delivery in those specific areas starting at **12:01 am on Monday October 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2018**. Canada Post continues to operate across Canada. They are accepting and delivering mail and parcels in all other locations.
